

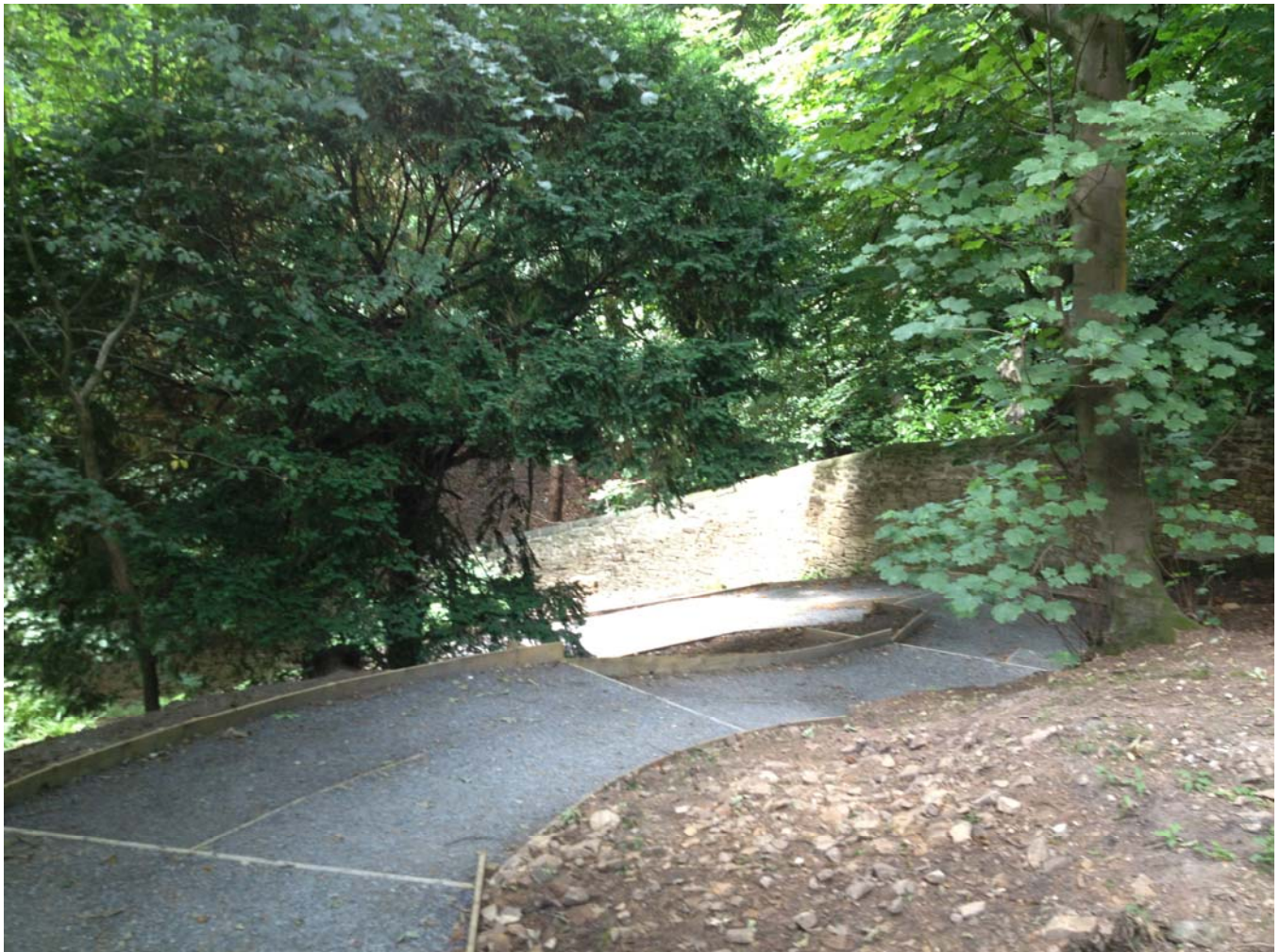
Lancaster City Council – Williamson Park Pathways

Installation and renovation of pathways, improving access for all.

Project Brief:

Lancaster City council commissioned the work to renovate the existing paths and to re-develop a third of the trail to provide access for everyone; young, old and disabled. Installing ramps would give wheelchair access to some of the more inaccessible areas in the park, particularly the woodland. Poor drainage had caused considerable erosion of the pathways. Duncan was approached with the problems and objectives and came up with solutions and a plan of action.



Project Overview

All pathways were cleared of vegetation, grading paths and altering the camber to re-direct the flow of water, edging was laid to retain the soil and prevent future erosion in the worst affected areas. A third of the pathway was completely re-developed. Wheelchair ramps were created and built alongside the existing steps for the general public.
